The stipend provided for artist pay, camera rental, and art materials. Sarah Couri, McClure Librarian, acquired supplies, arranged the scheduling, and facilitated the various sessions, and Peoria Public Library Deputy Director Roberta Koscielski oversaw the project and funding.

Alexa Cary, a founding member of the Peoria Guild of Black Artists and a professional photographer and artist based in Peoria, displayed her work at McClure Library and hosted office hours where she was available to give tips, answer questions, and critique work. Alexa taught an adult art class at McClure Library during which nine participants learned to take photographs with an artist's eye. She taught four classes at Peoria High during which five students learned about portrait photography, product photography, light painting, landscape/long distance photography, artistic/commercial themes, and presenting for a critique. The stipend provided for camera rental, flash drives for students, and albums of individual work for each student.

Kaitlyn Ostolaza, a Bradley University student studying graphic design but with experience in many different mediums, displayed her work at McClure Library and held office hours where she was available to answer questions, take a look at portfolios, and advise participants about the artistic process. She taught classes on visual art for five adults who practiced and developed their drawing and painting skills, each creating a painting on canvas. Kaitlyn taught four classes to elementary students at the Boys and Girls Club of Peoria during which she introduced sketching, different painting styles including watercolor/acrylic/oil, and 2-D/3-D design that included collaging and ceramics. Classes varied in size from 14-23 students. The stipend provided the paints/brushes, canvases/paper, clay, pencils, and sketch books.

Any unused materials will be used for McClure Branch Art-in-the-Park summer art program for children.

Roberta Koscielski, Connie Voss, Carol Sleeth, and Sarah Couri collaborated on the stipend application. Roberta Koscielski, Mary Jane Sterling, Mary Taylor, Kathy Johnson, Cathy Curtis, and Chris Berto assisted at the March/April sessions. Mary Jane Sterling supplied snacks.
