Professional Advancement and Outreach

When Independence Village of Peoria put in a call for help to Peoria Public Library, newly retired librarian and Nu Chapter member Roberta Koscielski asked other members to volunteer with her to organize the senior living center's resident library. Roberta, Chris Berto, Cathy Curtis, and friend Tom Menger worked over 3 days in late May/early June to sort, alphabetize, and shift hundreds of books that were on tables and interfile them with books already on the shelves in the resident library. Independence Village staff were pleased with the quickness of project completion and the volunteers enjoyed working with each other and with books.

In advance of the start of a new school year, Nu Chapter members volunteered to help Peoria Public Library staff at back to school events at select Peoria schools. Kathy Johnson, Mary Jane Sterling, Chris Berto, Julie Frank, and Cathy Curtis covered hours at Charter Oak, Holy Family, and Franklin schools to help children sign up for library cards and get library goodies.

September is Library Card Sign-Up Month and to encourage primary, middle, and high school students to have library cards, nine Nu Chapter members delivered stacks of library card applications to 30 Peoria schools. They will pick up completed applications and then deliver the new library cards to the schools after they have been issued by Peoria Public Library.

It was a pleasure to represent you all at the ILSO Exec meeting on September 17. Here are a few of the highlights.

- 1) Mary Jane Sterling was praised for her work in helping create a new, easier, more user friendly ("no more than 3 "clicks" to find anything!") ILSO website.
- 2) The M. Josephine O'Neil Arts award has been increased to up to \$10,000. The deadline for letters of intent to apply for the award is January 1.
- 3) If you request to receive the **Newscaster** on-line, use the password "sisters".
- 4) Several small changes in the Standing Rules were approved. Chris Berto has already updated our chapter rules to accommodate the changes.
- 5) Recommendations for State officers, committee chairs and committee members are due October 15 and the required forms (available on the ILSO website) are due by November 20.
- 6) The State membership committee is forming "affinity groups" from among the state DKG members to make it easier for women with common interests (gardening, Zentangle, quilting, etc.) to share their

enthusiasm and information via Zoom or social media.

Members verified directory and next of kin information. Mary Jane Sterling is investigating Wordpress rather Weebly for Nu's website.

Finance (Mary Jane Sterling) Total proceeds raised for Art Mart from sale of *Delicious Kitchen Gambits* cookbook and *Household Hints* will be available following sales at Creative Arts Retreat in June. March 2023 Book Discussion

As decided by the voters, Nu Chapter will discuss *The Bluest Eye* at our March 2023 meeting.

Here is some information about the book:

The Bluest Eye, debut novel by Nobel Prizewinning author Toni Morrison, was published in 1970. Set in Morrison's hometown of Lorain, Ohio, in 1940–41, the novel tells the tragic story of Pecola Breedlove, an African American girl from an abusive home. Elevenyear-old Pecola equates beauty and social acceptance with whiteness; she therefore longs to have "the bluest eye." Although largely ignored upon publication, The Bluest Eye is now considered an American classic and an essential account of the African American experience after the Great Depression. It is one of the top 10 most challenged books of 2021.
